Since the nineteenth century, people of Spain have united in song as a means of community involvement and expression of regional cultural identity. This unique tradition is upheld none more so than by the *bandas municipales* and it is indeed an honor to be able to host you in the company of Valencia's finest.



Conducted by Maestro Pablo Sanchez Torella, you will enjoy an exclusive concert by the Valencia Municipal Band founded in 1903 and one of the oldest in all of Spain. Such *bandas municipales* perform primarily on brass, woodwind and percussion instruments. What sets them apart from other “concert bands” is that the flute is used much more sparingly, the flugelhorn is used commonly as a solo instrument and the full range of the saxophone family, including the soprano and bass, is used regularly.
